

Highways Committee discussion with Nick Carofalo on Thursday 7th February
(Drop in event for Councillors)

1. Edworth Road

Reported that the edges of the road were eroding again. An inspection will take place and feedback on any action will be given.

We reported that increasing volume and speed of traffic especially during the evening and night made the road dangerous. A safety assessment suggested the road was adequate and no action on further white lining or improving the visibility of the edges would happen.

We mentioned the Gladman proposal for an additional 150 houses off Cambridge Road, Nick suggested a further safety review could occur if the plan goes ahead.

2. Station Road resurfacing - Nick will look at the schedule and feedback possible dates.

3. Alterations to junction south end of village - Need to contact Paul Salmon for an update

4. Renewal of footpaths in Cambridge Gardens, Way and Close -Work is currently scheduled for 4 to 22 March 2019

5. White lines at junction of Manor Close and Jubilee Lane - No action.

6. Potholes and Gulleys - Continue to report potholes on CBC portal. Gulley outside 68 High St has been inspected on needs repair, work to be scheduled and feedback given.
