

Summary of the review with CBC Highways – May 2018

Present: Nick Carofalo – CBC Area Steward, Richard Arnott - Langford PC

Repairs to roads

High Street – potholes have been noted and will be filled asap

Cambridge Road – expressed gratitude for the resurfacing work

Cambridge Close – “alligator cracking” to the road surface examined, problems under road surface are likely and may require a large repair. Situation to be reviewed with work to be done when the footpaths are resurfaced

Edworth Road – repairs to the edges of the road and potholes by the bridge are completed

Temporary barrier at junction by the former Boot – Paul Salmon (CBC) is leading a project to improve safety measures. It is likely to be 2 years before work is agreed and completed. LPC to maintain pressure for an appropriate solution. Speed cameras should be considered as more cost-effective solution than physical changes to the junction.

Station Road/Cambridge Road Junction – Running water, cause leak to be attended by Anglian Water, CBC to clear gulleys in Station Road

Blocked gulleys/drains – reported at Mill Lane/Church Street, Station Road/Church Street and by cottages news Burgess Homes Site.

Footpaths

Work to resurface the footpaths in Cambridge Gardens, Way and Close, Vicarage Close and Denny Crescent are planned and agreed but work is unlikely to start before the end of the financial year 2018/19.

Trees

Riverside Garden – Trees by the service road at Riverside Gardens were discussed. Work had been done on the two trees nearest to the entry to Riverside Gardens. The others need attention to remove the lowest branches and reduce the size of the trees in the similar way to those already done. This request will be reviewed by CBC (Tree specialist) and work done as needed.

Speeding – Continuous problem but not discussed
