Communication

The Council will continue to invest in and develop the Village Diary and Website and will continue to encourage resident's participation in the work of the council and its committees.

To achieve transparency all council minutes, agenda's, committee reports and financial statements will be published on the website on a monthly/quarterly basis.

Planning and Development

The Council will strive to uphold the local authority's development strategy it supported and will robustly oppose those developments that threaten the village dynamics.

The Council will strive to achieve community benefits from those developments it supports.

The Council will provide its full support to St Andrews Church PCC to ensure its burial capability is maintained whilst the planned new cemetery is constructed.

The Council will assist and encourage local organisations to utilise the funding available from the Wind Farm Community Fund.

The Council will lobby the local authority and agencies to ensure services keep pace with demand in the short-term specifically pre-school capacity.

Village Assets

The Council will continue to invest in the Village Hall, Playing Field and War Memorial to ensure these facilities are maintained and developed to the highest standards.

Financials

The Council will strive to operate within its budget and make known to the community at large how the precept is calculated and spent.

The Council will endeavour to support those village organisations that require additional help to fulfil their potential.

Highways and Environment

The Council will encourage residents to report highways, footpath and environmental issues to the local authority through using the community communication routes in place.

The Council will monitor and report on the local authority's progress towards resolution through regular inspections and the use of the FixMyStreet.com website.

The Council will keep under constant review those street lights for which it is responsible ensuring that sufficient funds are allocated to enable speedy correction of faults and replacement if required.
